#### School News — 18 September A.D. 2016

What's New at Our Savior for 2016-17? Every new school year brings changes to our school. In past weeks we have shared information about new staff and students, but what else is new this year?

Because there was money available in a designated technology fund, the Wi-Fi throughout the entire facility was replaced and upgraded, and outdated teacher computers in classrooms were replaced.

We were able to purchase ten additional desks and twenty new student chairs due to the increased enrollment and an additional classroom being used. Money had been set aside for school furniture several years ago that allowed us to do this.

A new reading curriculum was purchased for all students in kindergarten through third grade. This investment in teaching reading skills to our students was made possible by a grant from the Bretzlaff Foundation.

After replacing the library computer, it was discovered that the old software was not compatible with the new computer. After some research and discussions with some contacts at a public library, a very affordable program was discovered. PTL has agreed to cover the costs of the initial subscription. Once the setup of the program takes place and book information is imported into the new system, our students will be checking out books similar to the way they do at a public library.

Thanks be to God for these changes and improvements for our teachers, students, and their families!
