# **Child Safety and Supervision**

Upon the concern of several observers, I have been asked to remind our community of Michigan Penal Code 750.135a: Leaving child unattended in vehicle. "A person who is responsible for the care or welfare of a child shall not leave that child unattended in a vehicle for a period of time that poses an unreasonable risk of harm or injury to the child or under circumstances that pose an unreasonable risk of harm or injury to the child. "Child" means an individual less than 6 years of age. "Unattended" means alone or without the supervision of an individual 13 years of age or older who is not legally incapacitated."

#### **Classroom Christmas Parties**

Parties will be held on Friday, December 20 in the afternoon, following the PTL Christmas Lunch. Each class may exchange gifts with classmates in different ways; your classroom teacher or room mom will inform you of this. Please help children to be kind and considerate when it comes to gift-giving. For example, please keep these gifts under \$8 or homemade. A child may want to do more, but out of consideration for other families, please keep it simple. If students wish to exchange personal gifts with other friends, please do this outside of school, unless they bring something for everyone in their class. This will prevent hurt feelings and keep a good climate of togetherness in the classroom.

Note: On this day, the dress code is relaxed, and students may wear their most festive Christmas attire if they wish.
