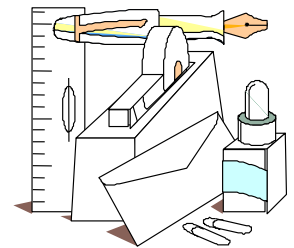
2023-2024 Supply List

PLEASE NOTE:

- Place names on all items as possible. All clothing must have the child's name on it.
- Pencils: **Wooden No. 2 pencils ONLY.** (Plastic coated and rubber pencils ruin sharpeners.)
Good brands: Dixon, Ticonderoga, or America's Pencil USA Gold
No retractable erasers in Grades 1 – 5.
- No pencil sharpeners. (Classrooms are equipped with a pencil sharpener.)
- Pens: Grades PS - 2: No pens.
Grades 3 - 8: **Blue or black ballpoint pens ONLY** -- NO gel pens.
- No 'White-Out' allowed at school.
- Supplies will need to be replenished at times during the school year.

Preschool & Pre-Kindergarten

- a tote bag or backpack for carrying things back and forth between home and school
- 1 pair child-sized scissors (**Label with student's name.**)
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 box crayons - 3 year-old Preschool
- 1 box 24-count, regular-sized crayons - 4 year-old Pre-Kindergarten
- 1 Box 10-count markers – 4 year old Pre-Kindergarten
- 1 pkg. 100-count 5 oz. cups
- 1 pocket folder (**Label with student's name.**)
- 1 plastic crayon box to store school supplies (no larger than 8½" x 5½") (**Label with student's name.**)
- clean clothes to be kept in their backpack (at least one complete change of clothing: a shirt, a pair of pants or a skirt/jumper, underwear, a pair of socks) – **label with name**
- gym shoes (to be left at school) – (**Label with student's name and P4.**)
- Playdough – 15-pack 1 ounce



Grades K and 1

- 2 boxes crayons, regular size, classic colors, non-washable, 24 count max.
- 1 Standard size Pencil Box
- 1 box (10 broad line) Crayola Markers - classic colors (1st only)
- 1 pocket folder (to carry papers between school and home)
- 1 pair child-sized, pointed, Fiskars scissors (**Label with student's name.**)
- 1 box of 120-count minimum tissues
- 1 pkg. of 300-count napkins
- 12 wooden pencils (Please, no plastic coated pencils. They ruin our pencil sharpener.)
- 1 book bag or backpack
- 2 large Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 good soft eraser (*Magic Rub* is a good brand.)

- clean uniform clothes in a large Ziploc bag (at least one complete change of clothing: a shirt, a pair of pants or a skirt/jumper, underwear, a pair of socks) – **label with name**

Grades 6 – 8 *Please see additional information below.*

- 8½" X 11" lined paper (wide-ruled only - No tear out tablets.) – several packages
- No. 2 wooden pencils (enough for school year) (mechanical pencils OK)
- 2 packets of 100 3x5 Index cards white or colored
- binder – such as a trapper or organizer (Required)
- 3 hole punch folders for binder (at least 6)
- colored pencils (16 or 24 per box)
- scissors (not child-sized)
- 2 solid glue sticks
- 3 boxes of tissues
- ballpoint pens (blue, black, and red for correcting)
- 1 ruler – 12" with metric measurement
- 1 pencil pouch
- 6 single subject, spiral, wide-ruled notebooks
- 3 3-subject, spiral, wide-ruled notebooks
- gym shoes (to be left at school) – **label with name**
- gym clothing for PE class (see dress code)
- paper or cloth (no adhesive) book covers
- Graph Paper
- Compass (grades 6&7 only)

Grades 2 – 8: Every hardbound book must be covered with paper or cloth book covers. Covering books helps them last longer. Brown paper bags work well for hardcover books. Please make sure your child's books remain covered for the entire year. Fees for damaged books are assessed at the end of each school year.

Gym shoes (with non-marking soles) are to be worn only for PE Class and other gym activities and should be kept at school. – **label with name**

Students in grades 2 – 8 are required to have an ESV Bible. Students who currently have an NIV Bible may use it; however, the religion curriculum used at the school has changed to the ESV for all Bible readings and notations. Some students may find it confusing to follow along in an NIV Bible which has slightly different wording. It is recommended that students who have not previously purchased a Bible as part of the school curriculum should use an ESV Bible. This item can be purchased at orientation or through the school office. Cost of a Bible purchased through the school is \$23.00.

Students in Grades 2 – 8 are required to have a Lutheran Service Book. This can be purchased at orientation or through the school office for \$32.00.

Students in Grades 5 – 8 are required to have an ESV Luther's Small Catechism. This can be purchased at orientation or through the school office for \$25.00.

Students in Grade 4 are required to have a recorder instrument. This will be purchased at orientation for \$11.00 and handed out the first day of music class.

Students in Grade 5 are required to rent a band instrument. This will come up in October via the Band teacher after students have had a chance to try different instruments. If you have financial need, please contact the school office.
